## **ECONOMIC IMPACT**

Sanford's economic activity in Minnesota supported more than **17,200 jobs** and generated more than **\$1.1 billion** in employment wages and benefits.

Minnesota's GDP grew by

\$1.5 billion due to Sanford's
combined economic impact.
Sanford contributed \$2.6 billion
to Minnesota's economy.

With construction factored in, an additional annual average of **200** Minnesotans found employment and **\$14.5** million in wages over the past four years. These projects contributed an average of **\$36.1** million to the economy each year.
